

CHINESE ART CLUB

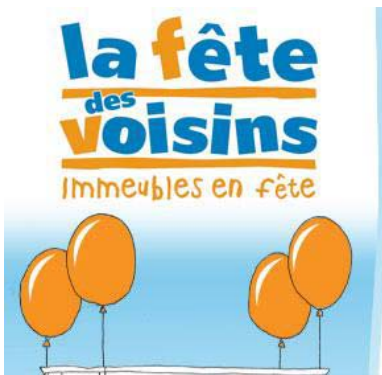
