## **Important Upcoming College Application Dates for Grades 11 and 12 Canadian, UK and USA**

### Testing Schedule:

Grade 12 students should complete all testing at the very latest by the January test date.

Register for the SAT online at [www.collegeboard.com/reg](http://www.collegeboard.com/reg) and for the ACT online at [www.act.org](http://www.act.org). Testing centers in Paris are at the American School of Paris (ASP) and EABJM. Standby places for students who did not register in time may be available at ASP, contact Ms. Hopkinson as soon as possible.

### College Applications to the U.S. for Grade 12 Students:

Deadlines for many schools in the U.S. are January 1 or 15. Students must have all documents to the college counsellor and forms to teachers for recommendations before December 1. Students should provide Ms. Hopkinson and the teachers writing recommendations with a list of their selected colleges which includes the admission deadlines and the correct mailing addresses (for Ms. Hopkinson).

### **College Applications to the U.K. for Grade 12 Students:**

All applications to U.K. universities are made online through UCAS ([www.ucas.com](http://www.ucas.com)). The UCAS deadline is January 15. However, for ISP students the college counsellor advises sending applications before the winter vacation in December. Students interested in applying to the U.K. should have their applications completed including the personal statement by December 1. Students who have completed their applications before this date will have their applications sent as soon as the reference is completed by the college counsellor. (Admissions of applications in November and early December are encouraged.)

For both U.S. and U.K. applications, students must fill out the Student Profile College Background questionnaire before Ms. Hopkinson can write their recommendations. For teacher recommendations for the U.S., students should complete the Teacher Student Questionnaire. Both forms are available in the counseling office or on the ISP University Counseling webpage.

## **College Applications to Canada for Grade 12 Students:**

Canadian universities have later deadlines than the U.K. or U.S. Students register online by January 15 to some universities and in February and March to other schools. However, applying earlier than the deadlines is encouraged. Students must provide a list of the schools to which they are applying to Ms. Hopkinson and include the correct address and deadlines for the documentation to be sent, which usually includes the transcript, a school profile, and predicted grades.

### 日本の大学入試準備に関するお知らせ

来年の4月頃に志望校を5校までI.B.に提出します。そうするとI.B.の結果が自動的に大学に送られます。また、9月入学やAO入試の場合は、早めに提出書類や願書を準備する必要がありますので、大学のホームページ等で確認してください。成績証明書や卒業証明書は卒業時に必要部数を学校で準備しますが、推薦状等は早目に個別に依頼してください。

12학년의 경우, 외국대학으로 진학하는 학생이 많은 걸로 알고 있습니다. 이제 시간이 얼마 남지 않았으므로 IB 시험을 집중적으로 준비해야 하며, 한국어로 들어가는 학생의 경우, 따로 특례입학을 위해 공부해야 할 것입니다. 특히 수학과목은 입학 당락의 결정을 좌우하는 과목이므로 체계적으로 꼼꼼히 공부해야 하며, 영어의 경우 TOEFL, SAT에서 좋은 점수를 얻어야 유리합니다. 국어의 경우도 ISP에서는 IB 위주로 수업이 진행되기 때문에 특례입학을 위해서는 따로 준비해야 할 부분도 많습니다.
