

## Job Description for Holiday Language Programme English Teacher

The International School of Paris Holiday Language Programme offers an inclusive and diverse learning environment based at our Primary School campus.

Our programme attracts students from all around the world and is a great opportunity for them to improve their language skills by immersing themselves in our interactive and exciting classes.

Language immersion, in English or in French, happens in small groups that welcome children from ages 3 to 16.

Students learn through collaboration, practising focused vocabulary, working on grammar, creative arts and crafts activities, as well as outdoor sports and games.

Students create a weekly personal project linking language learning with their themed excursions in Paris.

Teachers' duties include to :

- Develop the themes and teaching content for the different weeks of the programme in collaboration with the ISP Plus Holiday Language Programme Coordinator, in line with general guidelines giving by the Head of School.
- Hand in a complete and detailed plan and curriculum for the four weeks to the Coordinator of the Holiday Language Program before the start of the programme.
- Adapt the teaching to the students' needs by differentiating in regards to language proficiency, age and personality of the students.
- Develop a genuine interest and motivation in learning the language in all students by offering an engaging, positive and dynamic learning environment.
- Organise pedagogical activities that promote the use of language interactions between the students while respecting the pedagogical frame defined by the Holiday Language Programme.
- Plan and deliver age appropriate afternoon activities linked to the theme that has been determined for each week.
- Accompany the students on the field trips. Prepare the visits and pedagogical activities for each trip.
- Participate in the weekly staff meeting scheduled by the Coordinator.
- Publish samples of each students work and achievements daily using the tool put into place by the Coordinator to keep parents informed on their children's progressions.

The position is based at the International School of Paris in the 16th arrondissement of Paris.
