

## International School of Paris Cookie Policy

Cookies are small text files exchanged between the web-server and your browser each time a page is visited. Cookies typically perform functions intended to enhance your browsing experience. For example, they may allow the web-server to remember your preferences, or they may be there to allow you to display certain media files such as vimeo.

Some cookies are session based, these are deleted when you leave the website, others are persistent, these are remembered after you leave the website.

Most web browsers allow you to block cookies but you should be aware that doing so may negatively affect the functionality of the site.

Cookies can also be used to capture information about website traffic and individual user's interactions with the site.
